

**MAVERICK COUNTY, TEXAS**  
**SEVENTH DECLARATION OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**  
**WITH THE CONSENT OF MAVERICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT**  
**SUPPLEMENTING AND/OR AMENDING THE CURRENT DISASTER**  
**DECLARATIONS BY AND/OR REVISING MEASURES TO PREPARE FOR,**  
**RESPOND TO AND MITIGATE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19.**

**WHEREAS**, on May 18, 2020 the Governor of the State of Texas issued an executive order GA-23 expanding the opening of the State of Texas in response to the COVID-19 disaster and providing additional clarifying orders to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Judge, with the consent and approval of Maverick County Commissioner's Court, finds it necessary and appropriate and in the public interest and for the public good to extend, amend, and/or modify the Disaster Declarations in order to continue with the extraordinary protective measures and efforts afforded by the previous Declarations of Disaster;

**WHEREAS**, the County Judge, with the consent and approval of Maverick County Commissioner's Court, finds it necessary and appropriate for citizens to abide and comply with all disaster declaration orders issued by the Governor of the State of Texas and/or President of the United States.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY JUDGE SAUCEDO OF MAVERICK COUNTY, TEXAS, AND WITH THE CONSENT OF MAVERICK COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT:**

SECTION 1. The following is hereby added and shall read as follows:

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the existing and most current Declaration of Disaster executed by the County Judge and County Commissioners. on April 8, 2020, is hereby renewed, extended, superseded and modified as stated herein and shall continue to be in full force and effect until Maverick County deems it unnecessary to continue.

SECTION 2.

This Declaration will supersede all previous Declarations issued by the County Judge and County Commissioners with the exception of any rights, duties, and powers authorized by the County Commissioners to the designated Local Health Authority and as otherwise noted in Exhibit 1 which shall continue to remain in effect. If there is a conflict between the declarations issued by this governing body and the orders issued by the Governor of Texas or the President of the United States, the more restrictive declaration requirements will control.

SECTION 3 The County Commissioners adopts and incorporates any subsequent orders issued by the Governor of Texas as part of the Local Disaster Declaration until further action.

SECTION 4. To adhere and follow any and all orders issued by the Governor as it relates to COVID-19, and hereby adopting the GOVERNOR'S ORDERS relating to the expanded opening as in Executive Order GA 23, and any subsequent orders issued by the Governor as they relate to COVID-19, until further action by this Commissioners Court.

SECTION 5.: Entry into essential stores shall be recommended to one person per family and minors may be allowed entry if accompanied by their parent and/or guardian.

SECTION 6: To adhere and follow all applicable laws under the Texas Health and Safety Code and the Texas criminal statutes relating to communicable diseases, Local Health Authority powers, and criminal violations for failing to comply with isolation and quarantine orders

- SECTION 7: This declaration, with the consent of Maverick County Commissioner's Court, is issued because of the propensity of the COVID-19 to spread person to person, and because the virus physically causing property loss and damage.
- SECTION 8. That this declaration, with the Consent of the Maverick County Court, hereby authorizes the use of all lawfully available enforcement tools.
- SECTION 9. That this declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
