**STANDING ORDER FOR FIXING
AMOUNT OF BAIL**

On this day came on to be considered the D.A. bond recommendations for the Grand Jury Indictments presented on June 19, 2020.

The undersigned judges of the district courts of Maverick County, Texas, find that as a matter of law bail should be sufficiently high, yet not oppressive, to give reasonable assurance that a Defendant will appear and answer before the court the accusation brought against him/her. That among some of the factors that the courts should consider in setting bail are the nature of the offense and the circumstances under which it was committed, as well as the future safety of a victim of the alleged offense and the community.

Since these courts at the time that an indictment is presented are not likely to know anything about an alleged offense or whether the Defendant may be a potential flight risk, we, the undersigned, have endeavored to request the District Attorney to submit reasonable bond recommendations for the courts' consideration.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 293RD District Attorney provide to the appropriate court in which an indictment is presented within 3 business days from the presentment of said indictment adequate information concerning the factors that the court should consider in setting appropriate bail under the circumstances. Among the information that is herein ordered to be submitted to the appropriate court named below is the nature of the alleged offense and the circumstances under which it was committed, the future safety of a victim, if any, and the community, and any relevant factors regarding whether the Defendant

may be a potential flight risk, including, but not limited to, the Defendant's place of residence and any prior criminal history.
