

Notice of Foreclosure Sale

1. *Property to Be Sold.* The property to be sold is described as follows:

Being 0.953 Acre Tract out of Survey 27, Abstract 840, known and hereby designated as Lot 2C-1, in Tract 1, of Block 1, of the Quintas Fronterizas Subdivision in Maverick County, Texas and being the same land described in deed from Maria Elena Mendez Medrano and Mario Mendes to Roberto Munoz et ux, dated March 26, 1987, recorded in Volume 245, Page 202, Deed Records of Maverick County, Texas, reference being here made to said deed and the record thereof for a further description of said land and for all purposes.

2. *Instrument to be Foreclosed.* The instrument to be foreclosed is that certain deed of trust dated March 1, 2019:

Grantor: Nathan De La Cerda and Christina Salazar De La Cerda

Recorded in: Document No. 206952, Book 1755, Pages 95-103, Official Public Records of Maverick County, Texas.

3. *Date, Time, and Place of Sale.* The sale is scheduled to be held at the following date, time, and place:

Date: June 7, 2022

Time: The sale will begin no earlier than 1:00 p.m., or no later than three hours thereafter. The sale will be completed by no later than 4:00 p.m.

Place: Maverick County Courthouse in Eagle Pass, Texas, at the following location: At the steps at the front of the Maverick County Courthouse, 500 Quarry Street, Eagle Pass, Maverick County, Texas 78852.

The deed of trust permits the beneficiary to postpone, withdraw, or reschedule the sale for another day. In that case, the trustee or substitute trustee under the deed of trust need not appear at the date, time, and place of a scheduled sale to announce the postponement, withdrawal, or rescheduling. Notice of the date of any rescheduled foreclosure sale will be reposted and refiled in accordance with the posting and filing requirements of the Texas Property Code. The reposting or refiled may be after the date originally scheduled for this sale.

4. *Terms of Sale.* The sale will be conducted as a public auction to the highest bidder for cash, subject to the provisions of the deed of trust permitting the beneficiary thereunder to have the bid credited to the note up to the amount of the unpaid debt secured by the deed of trust at the time of sale.

Those desiring to purchase the property will need to demonstrate their ability to pay their bid immediately in cash if their bid is accepted.

The sale will be made expressly subject to any title matters set forth in the deed of trust, but prospective bidders are reminded that by law the sale will necessarily be made subject to all prior matters of record affecting the property, if any, to the extent that they remain in force and effect and have not been subordinated to the deed of trust. The sale shall not cover any part of the property that has been released of public record from the lien of the deed of trust. Prospective bidders are strongly urged to examine the applicable property records to determine the nature and extent of such matters, if any.

Pursuant to the deed of trust, the beneficiary has the right to direct the Trustee to sell the property in one or more parcels and/or to sell all or only part of the property.

Pursuant to section 51.009 of the Texas Property Code, the property will be sold in "as is, where is" condition, without any express or implied warranties, except as to the warranties of title (if any) provided for under the deed of trust. Prospective bidders are advised to conduct an independent investigation of the nature and physical condition of the property.

Pursuant to section 51.0075 of the Texas Property Code, the trustee reserves the right to set further reasonable conditions for conducting the sale. Any such further conditions shall be announced before bidding is opened for the first sale of the day held by the trustee or any substitute trustee.

5. *Type of Sale.* The sale is a nonjudicial deed-of-trust lien and security interest foreclosure sale being conducted pursuant to the power of sale granted by the deed of trust executed by Nathan De La Cerda and Christina Salazar De La Cerda.

6. *Obligations Secured.* The deed of trust provides that it secures the payment of the indebtednesses and obligations therein described (collectively, the "Obligations") including but not limited to (a) the promissory note in the original principal amount of ONE-HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100ths DOLLARS (\$115,000.00), executed by Nathan De La Cerda and Christina Salazar De La Cerda, and payable to the order of Ana Maria C. Morales, and (b) all renewals and extensions of the note. Ana Maria C. Morales is the current owner and holder of the obligation and is the beneficiary under the deed of trust.

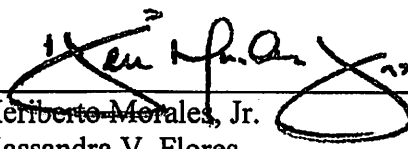
As of May 13, 2022, there was owed \$103,030.75 on the note, being principal, interest and legal fees in the following amounts: \$ 100,861.20 of principal, \$369.55 of interest; \$1,800.00 in legal fees expended in connection with the collection of the Note. The note is bearing interest at the rate of \$50.62 per day thereafter.
