

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Commissioners Court of Maverick County, Texas (the "County"), will meet at its regular meeting place in the Maverick County Courthouse, Eagle Pass, Texas at 5:00 p.m. on September 12, 2022 (unless alternative meeting arrangements are required to address public health concerns, which meeting arrangements will be specified in the notice of such meeting posted in accordance with applicable law), which is the time and place tentatively set for the passage of an order and such other action as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance from time to time of one or more series of the County's certificates of obligation (the "Certificates"), in the maximum aggregate principal amount not to exceed EIGHT MILLION DOLLARS (\$8,000,000), payable from ad valorem taxes and from a limited pledge of revenues of the County's water system, bearing interest at any rate or rates not to exceed the maximum interest rate authorized by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the County Commissioners Court on or before the date of issuance of the Certificates, and maturing over a period not to exceed twenty (20) years from the date of issuance, for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness of the County for all or any part of the costs of contractual obligations incurred or to be incurred associated with (i) renovating, repairing, improving, or equipping existing buildings or facilities, including County roads, and related bridge construction and improvements, utilities relocation, safety and signalization, related road drainage, bike lanes and sidewalk improvements; (ii) acquisition of vehicles and equipment for county departments and purposes; (iii) acquire, construct, improve, repair, rehabilitate County buildings, facilities, equipment, rights-of-way, land, for streets, roads, highways, bridges, sidewalks, parks, water and sewer system, landfill, parking structures, telecommunications, information technology systems applications, hardware, or software, cybersecurity, other County public safety facilities, judicial facilities and flood control and drainage facilities; (iv) acquiring materials, supplies, equipment, machinery, land, easements, rights-of-way and other interests in real property for authorized needs and purposes relating to any of the foregoing purposes; and (v) professional services of attorneys, engineers and other professionals in connection with the above-described purposes, and the costs of issuance of the Certificates, including but not limited to fees for professional services and incidental expenses related to such purposes. The estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the Certificates on time and in full is \$12,420,650. Such estimate is provided for illustrative purposes only and is based on an assumed interest rate of 4.50%. Market conditions affecting interest rates vary based on a number of factors beyond the control of the County, and the County cannot and does not guarantee a particular interest rate associated with the Certificates. As of the date of this notice, the aggregate principal amount outstanding of tax-supported debt obligations of the County is \$34,469,000, and based on the County's expectations, as of the date of this notice the combined principal and interest required to pay all of the outstanding tax-supported debt obligations of the County on time and in full is \$42,043,026.
